

**CASCADE VOLLEYBALL CLUB OF SEATTLE  
TRAVEL CONTRACT**

This contract is designed to clearly state what is expected on the road during club travel. We appreciate your understanding and cooperation in regards to this contract as it is designed for your safety. We sincerely appreciate your support in helping us maintain a positive image when traveling and maximize our competitive edge while on the road. As a USVA organization we will abide by the rules/ guidelines and penalties of the USVA Code of Contact.

1. If you are traveling without a parent you are under the supervision of the chaperone and therefore not allowed to go out with another player and their parent without the written permission of your parent. For trips to Canada the notarized letter of travel will serve as written permission.
2. We must be aware of your whereabouts at all times. You must have the permission of your team chaperone or coach to leave the hotel/playing site at anytime. You are not allowed to go out in cars with anyone other than the chaperone, coach or your parent. You must tell the team chaperone/coach when going via any other vehicle than the team car.
3. If you are not sleeping in your parent's room you will be assigned to a shared player room. Absolutely no members of the opposite sex in your rooms at any time. This restriction also applies to opposite sex family members in your rooms if other players are present.
4. All players must be in their rooms when stated by the chaperone or coach and have lights out by time noted. Lights out means no lights, TV or cell phones in use.
5. Every player is responsible for making sure all his teammates are on time to meetings, games, meals, rides, etc. You are responsible for making sure everyone is in your room by curfew and going to be on time.
6. Be considerate of other guests in the hotel. Absolutely no yelling, running, or slamming of any doors during our stay in the hotel.
7. Every player is responsible for the room's cleanliness. You will have multiple players sharing the room. Clean your space and be courteous to your roommates. This also goes for travel in cars, benches and team areas at the playing facility. Clean up after yourselves!
8. No illegal drugs, alcohol, or gambling will be allowed in the presence of any of our athletes. If a player is around or associated with people with drugs, alcohol or gambling we will assume that you are participating in those acts and will be sent home at the expense and responsibility of your family.
9. BUDDY SYSTEM. You must always be with at least one other person if you leave your room. We require at least three people in groups when not at the playing site or hotel. Make sure if you leave to do anything, you have a buddy with you. **NO EXCEPTIONS.** (i.e. if you want to go to the vending machines or walk to parent/coach/chaperone room bring someone with you)
10. Some coaches may have a team dress code when traveling. If no dress code is specified we ask that you dress with respect and remember you are representing a group, and therefore you refrain from wearing inappropriate clothing at all times when on the road.

If any problems arise, we will not hesitate to send players home at your family's expense as we expect all the time you demonstrate respect for our team, club and yourselves by following the rules. Having received your signed copy of this travel agreement we will assume that there will be no issues or problems and traveling will be a fun, safe and great competitive experience for all of us. Families please keep a copy for your records.
